

Configuring a Netgear ME102 802.11b Access Point. App Note 8.

The Netgear ME102 is a very low cost Access Point. The key reason for this is that it is not capable of point-to-point communication.

This means that you can not use two Netgear ME102 products to form the radio link. If this is your intention, the ELSA Lancom is the correct choice.

However, the Netgear is an excellent choice for connecting a radio based controller or 'Rigger's Remote' into the network. Examples of this include receiving data from the Artistic Licence 'Light-Spring' or 'Grand-Master Flash!' products.

Configuration:

- (1) In most cases, you do not need to configure the wireless access point for it to work with the Art-Net protocol.
- (2) If you do have unique, network requirements please refer to the documentation that accompanies the access point.
